Introduction

As deployed volunteers, we may find ourselves working along side state and municipal emergency managers, FEMA staff and other voluntary agencies. In order to integrate well, we must all understand and speak the same "language" when responding to a disaster. This page contains resources and recommended courses from the FEMA Emergency Management Institute's Independent Study Program, including the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and the Incident Command System (ICS). Also included are several additional online resources and training videos from PDA and other sources that will provide information and tools you can use in the field.

FEMA Courses

FEMA Independent Study (IS) online courses can be found at https://training.fema.gov/is/crslist.aspx

PDA does not require these, but the following are required to be NIMS compliant.

- IS 100-Introduction to the Incident Command System
- IS 700-National Incident Management System (NIMS), an Introduction
- IS 800-National Response Plan (NRP), an Introduction
- IS 200- ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents
 - o These courses are offered online, and are the prerequisites for:
- ICS 300-Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents
- ICS 400-Advanced ICS for Command and General Staff
 - These courses are only offered in classroom settings because they are designed for group interaction.
